### LAST DAY TO DONATE IS FEB. 13TH!!

This program helps purchase a book for every Emerald Parks student receiving additional help with reading. It is



the one fundraiser where your dollar is worth more. Every dollar raised is worth at least \$1.65 (if we meet our spring book fair sales goal it will be worth \$1.70). A \$10 donation will allow us to purchase \$16.50 in books and Scholastic matches the \$10 by donating 10 books to either the Kids in Distressed Situations, Inc. or the Kids In Need Foundation. Donations are still being accepted until February 13<sup>th</sup>, 2013. Donation Envelopes can be found in the main office or you can put your donation in your child's white envelope. Please ensure donations are marked as designated for the One For Books program.

We are just shy of being 50% to our \$850 goal. Our very successful bake sale during pizza night raised \$136, bringing our balance up to \$416.00. Thank you to those who were able to donate to the cause.

### **FALL FUNDRAISING SUCCESS...**

Thank you so much to all the parents, neighbors, relatives, and friends who contributed to our Fall Fundraiser this year. Over 100 students collected orders, either from the Northwest Collection Gift Catalog and/or from sharing the internet ordering system.

## Because of your support, we sold \$10,941.50 resulting in \$5,141.55 for the PTSA.

The money raised allows the PTSA to help school programs such as transportation for field trips, assemblies, teachers requests for classroom supplies, and much, much more!

In addition to the money raised for the fall fundraiser, 36 students received bonus prizes from our Mystery Prize drawings held throughout the fundraiser.


### **FALL CLOTHING DRIVE**


